Title: Supplier Quality Engineer

Description Summary:

Springfield is accepting applications for the position of Supplier Quality Engineer (SQE). As a member of the Quality Assurance Department, the SQE ensures vendor compliance. Acts as liaison between the company and the suppliers to manage and deploy continuous improvement initiatives and a continuous flow of defect free parts.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Communicates and works cooperatively with customers and suppliers to ensure products and services exceed internal and external customer expectations.
- Interacts with Quality Control, Purchasing, Product Engineering, and Production to understand, quantify, and communicate problems back to suppliers through written reports, inspection documents, photos, emails, and verbal communication.
- Facilitates and participates in root cause problem-solving activities. Participates in this process from issue discovery, identification through resolution. Works to guarantee timely corrective and preventive actions are in place.
- Responds to quality spills of defective parts by organizing containment, preparing shipments for return or rework, coordinating logistics with suppliers, and initiating cost recoveries.
- Operates standard measurements and test equipment regularly. Participates in test fire and new product introduction activities as needed.
- Maintains accurate and detailed records of supplier performance, quality issues, and resolution actions to ensure traceability and support ongoing quality improvement efforts.
- Reviews and approves supplier quality documentation, such as deviations, supplier requests for engineering changes, and process changes.
- Supports the development and implementation of continuous improvement projects with production and engineering teams, driving initiatives to enhance product quality and operational efficiency.
- Supports supplier quality department with other tasks as needed.

Requirements:

Bachelor's degree in engineering from an ABET accredited institution is required. Demonstrated work history in Quality and project management with relevant certifications (Six Sigma Green Belt, ASQ Certified Quality Engineer) is preferred. Significant experience with firearm components and/or development of machined components is helpful. The ability to read and

interpret technical drawings is expected with experience in Geometric Dimensioning and Tolerancing (GD&T). Problem solving skills to include the utilization of Global 8D, Six Sigma, and Red-X. This position is trusted to handle and protect company-private information: discretion, integrity, and ethics nonnegotiable.
